3. To highlight translational research in liver disease and foster Canadian clinical and research collaborations in hepatology.

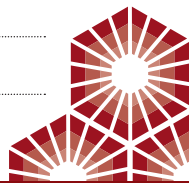

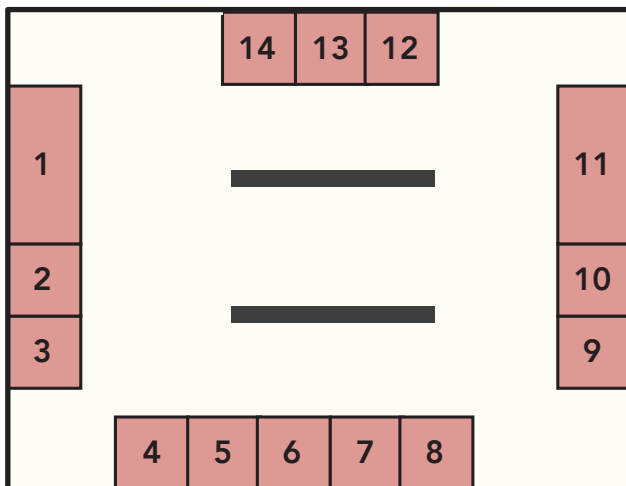

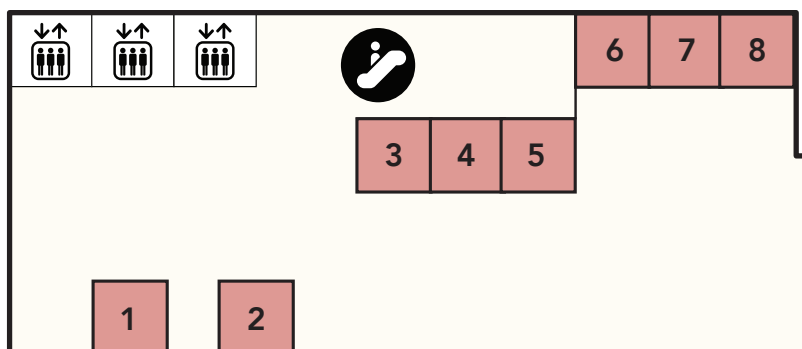
